Presented for Mayor and City Council consideration is a request to approve submission of a grant application to Story County for American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds for water and sewer infrastructure system improvements.

Story County will receive over \$18 Million in ARPA funds. The Story County Board of Supervisors is inviting communities, organizations, and external partners to submit proposals for funding consideration.

At its meeting on October 4th, the City Council adopted a resolution allocating Story City ARPA fund to sanitary sewer main lining projects and toward water and sewer infrastructure improvements.

The grant application is requesting funding in the amount of \$302,500 to be utilized toward: a) Lining, and related work, of sewer mains in order to prevent inflow and infiltration of rain and ground water into the sanitary sewer system. This is tentatively scheduled to be done on a portion of Lafayette Avenue (Oak to Eighth) and Maple Court, and b) Replacement of aging water mains on Larson Avenue, Market Avenue, Washington Street, and Eighth Street. The estimated total cost for these projects is \$690,000.
