To All Story County Polling Locations:

Thank you for your support of elections in Story County. We literally cannot hold elections without you.

This year has been especially challenging for all of us. We want our voters, our election workers, and our hosts to feel safe. Below is the list of all the things we are doing/providing in response to the COVID-19 pandemic:

All polling locations are supplied with personal protective equipment for all poll workers (masks, face shields, gloves) and one-time-use pens and secrecy folders for voters. We cannot require voters to wear masks or face coverings (it is strongly recommended) but everyone else (poll workers, poll watchers, media) will be required to wear a face covering.

On election day, equipment and high-touch areas will be sanitized by the poll workers on an as-needed basis or as time allows. Polls are open from 7 am to 9 pm; election workers arrive at 6 am and will be present until approximately 11 pm or midnight.

On Wednesday, November 4, coordinated to occur immediately following the pickup of equipment, each polling location will be professionally sanitized by our contractor IGH. This includes the room(s) used for the election plus high-touch areas.
