

Public Notification
Reporting Violation Of The Maximum
Residual Disinfectant Level

The Story City Water Department is required by state and federal regulations to submit a monthly report summarizing the disinfectant levels found in the drinking water.

This monthly summary is required to be submitted to the Iowa Department of Natural Resources to report whether or not the Maximum Residual Disinfectant level of 4.0 mg/L of total chlorine in the drinking water was exceeded during the previous 12 months. Chlorine is beneficial at low levels to control microbes, such as Coliform bacteria, but may have adverse health risks at excessive levels.

The Story City Water Department regrets its failure to report the Maximum Residual Disinfectant Level in February 2022 and will work to make sure that the required information is submitted in the future
